PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Expected completion date: December 2018

Under an agreement with the Authors of the Guide, Mr Philip Peng will lead the translation of the UNIDROIT/FAO/IFAD Legal Guide on Contract Farming into Chinese. Peking University Press has formally agreed to publish the printed volume and organise its distribution in the People's Republic of China and abroad. The printed book is expected to be released by 31 December 2018.

Mr Peng is a practicing lawyer and arbitrator in Beijing; Editor-in-chief of *Chinese Maritime and Commercial Law Reports* (published by Informa Law UK).

The availability of a Chinese (Mandarin) version of the Legal Guide will be instrumental for its dissemination in China, one of the world's largest agriculture countries, and contributing to enhance a favorable legal environment for contract farming in China and for Chinese operators.
