## Information on the economic situation of the Institute as of 20 November 2009

(memorandum of the UNIDROIT Secretariat)

- 1. Several member States that are members of the Finance Committee have expressed an interest in further details of the economic situation of the Institute, in particular as regards receipts for the current financial year. In order to meet this concern, the Secretariat herewith submits to the General Assembly a report on the economic situation of the Institute as of today's date (20 November 2009), including a breakdown of receipts up until that date as well as an indication of expenditure to date and an estimate of expenditure up to 31 December 2009.
- 2. As shown in the breakdown, at 20 November 2009 the economic situation of the Institute shows total receipts at that date (including the surplus on 1 January 2009 included in the 2009 budget) of  $\in$  2,238,999.03, whereas the estimate in the budget approved by the General Assembly at its 63<sup>rd</sup> session indicated receipts totalling  $\in$  2,285,850.00. The Institute may, however, receive further receipts in the period 20 November 31 December, in particular from States that have not yet paid their contribution for the current financial year (see the explanatory note to the Receipts, No. 3).
- 3. As to expenditure, it should be noted that even this late in the year, unforeseen events may change the estimated expenditure, and that some bills (heating, electricity, water) for the final quarter of the year have not yet arrived.
- 4. Taking all this into account, and if the Institute receives at least part of the outstanding contributions for the current financial year from those member States that have not yet paid up, the estimated expenditure of € 2,271,312.00, should be covered by receipts.
- 5. The Secretariat wishes to stress that it shall do its utmost to make savings where possible.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> This sum represents the payments received so far from the member States other than Italy, and it includes also the contributions of the two new member States, i.e. Indonesia and Saudi Arabia; as of 20 November 2009, one member State of Category IV, two of Category VII and 5 of Category VIII had not yet paid their contribution. Judging by experience in previous years, the Secretariat expects some of these member States to pay their outstanding contribution before 31 December 2009.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> This sum represents contributions from private donors, i.e. the UK Foundation for International Uniform Law, the American Foundation for International Uniform Law and the German Space Agency, allocated to various projects of the Institute.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>9</sup> This sum represents the surplus from the financial year 2008 included in the 2009 budget. It should be noted that, mostly due to the payment of arrears by several member States, the surplus on 1 January 2009 amounted in effect to € 237,798.08, i.e. € 157,798.08 more than foreseen. Part of this sum (€ 20,000.00) was allocated to raising the Working Capital Fund to an amount corresponding to 2/12 of total yearly expenditure, in accordance with the General Assembly's recommendation at its 53<sup>rd</sup> session (Rome, 25 November 1999); the Secretariat will submit a document to the Finance Committee at its 67<sup>th</sup> session in the first quarter of 2010 outlining its proposals for the allocation of the remaining part of this sum (€ 137,798.08).
