- 2. The Accounts for the 2009 financial year indicate that actual receipts (including the 2008 surplus amounting to \in 237,798.08) totalled \in 2,373,028.08 and actual expenditure \in 2,255,628.25, yielding a surplus for the year as a whole of \in 117,400.06. Receipts and expenditures in the special accounts, amounting to \in 13,515.71, show a balance.

To facilitate the reading of the Accounts, a summary of the receipts (in euro) is indicated below:
